We hope this past holiday season was filled with happiness and joy. I would like to extend an invitation to each of you to attend the 99th Anniversary Pig Banquet. This year's celebration will be held on April 2, 2016. Lunch will be served at noon at the chapter house with an alumni meeting on fourth floor following the festivities. As always, we welcome alumni to stop by the house any time and let us show you how "The House That Brotherhood Built" is our home.

Fall rush was an exciting time and brought us 19 initiates and we reached 2000 members. Already, they are highly involved with house operations and are eager to take over the reigns. Recruiting men on campus that exemplify our ideals comes naturally when so many actives possess the characteristics necessary for a top tier fraternity. Our academics finished strong with a chapter GPA of 3.107, ranking fourth overall within our 15 Fraternities and Sororities on campus. With an active chapter roster totaling 75 men, we take pride in our presence on campus, and are delighted with the 31 men currently living in-house.

On an International level, Theta Chi Fraternity is in an amazing state. With 155 active chapters we are charging full speed into a bright future. During the 2016 Inaugural Sasser Presidents Conference, International Headquarters launched the "Resolute Man" achievement. This award will allow undergraduates to have a continued involvement on their campus and in their community. IHQ also launched a rebranding of the fraternity logos and fonts. While our traditional symbols and signatures, such as the coat of arms, will remain, these new visual standards help bring us into the 21st century.

This past summer I had the pleasure of representing Phi Chapter at the 4th annual Initiative Academy. During this event Phi Chapter was awarded with the Phil S. Randall Award for success in recruitment. We also took home the Chapter Achievement Award for the 2014-2015 school year. As a chapter we are looking forward to our annual Mid-Year Leadership Conference, hosted by the Gamma Tau Chapter at Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa. Last year we had 23 actives attend and are anticipating matching our attendance this year. This summer is also

the 160th Anniversary Convention & 37th School of Fraternity Practices, taking place in Atlanta, Georgia. These nationally held events are a great way to meet brothers from across the country and learn how to improve our chapter operations.

Our alumni continue to be the support we need. This year we elected recent alumnus, Ryan Buetow, as our Faculty Advisor. He helps and supports us in all necessary aspects on campus. Hello fellow alumni! This year has been a busy time for the alumni counsel and Phi Now campaign committee. Financing for the renovation project has been secured through Bell State bank and we are planning to review construction bids this spring.

In 2015 we have received \$9,357 for the Theta Chi for Life campaign. Cumu- lative donations to Theta Chi for Life since the year 2000 now total \$130,720. Thank you to everyone that has been participating in this great program!

As of the time of this writing, the total amount pledged to the Phi Now cam- paign is currently \$1,272,806. The total donations we have received is current- ly \$664,651; of that amount \$403,162 has been given direct to the chapter and \$261,489 to the foundation. A huge thank you goes out to all of our donors for their generosity!
